While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed
on 12.04.2023:-

“It is submitted that the petitioner has been implicated in this case only on the disclosure of the co-accused and a single call made by him to the petitioner allegedly on the date of registration of the FIR. The same by itself is not sufficient to conclude that the petitioner was the supplier especially when there is no other case pending against the petitioner under the NDPS Act, 1985.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Himmat Singh, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State and waives service.

The petitioner is directed to join investigation with the Investigating Officer on 24.04.2023 at 10.00 a.m. and cooperate therewith.

In the event of his arrest, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the

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Investigating Officer/SHO concerned subject to his compliance of the conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Adjourned to 03.07.2023.”

2. Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Om Parkash, has stated that pursuant to the order dated 12.04.2023, the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.
3. In view of above, the interim order dated 12.04.2023 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions as enumerated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
4. This petition stands disposed off.
