The matter is being heard on the request of counsel for the petitioners, who submits that there is imminent danger to the lives and liberty of the petitioners.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking direction to respondent No.2 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners.

The counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are into live-in relationship which is being opposed by respondents No.4 to 7, who are related to petitioner No.1. The counsel for the petitioners further

submits that respondents No.4 to 7 are extending threats to cause harm to the petitioners and in this regard representation dated 07.04.2023 (Annexure P-5) is already given to respondent No.2, but the police authorities have failed to take any action against the private respondents.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Roopse Sharma, Advocate for Mr. Anil Kumar Lamdharia, Addl. P.P. accepts notice on behalf of U.T. Chandigarh. She submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.

In view of above, without going into merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider representation dated dated 07.04.2023 (Annexure P-5) and to provide appropriate protection to the petitioners if so warranted. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the relationship between the petitioners.

Respondents No.4 to 7 are at liberty to avail appropriate legal remedy against the petitioners.

In case the petitioners have committed any offence, the law will take its own course.
