The present writ petition has been filed for seeking release
of Truck bearing registration No.RJ-14-GB-1190.

The primary grievance espoused by the petitioner in the
present petition was that the loan amount between the parties has already
been settled, however, the vehicle in question is not being released on
account of demand of Rs.4,50,000/- that were being demanded by the
Yard Manager.

Learned counsel for the respondent-Bank graciously
submits that as against the demand of Rs.4,50,000/- towards the holding

charges, the Bank would direct release of the vehicle in favour of the petitioner in the event of deposit of Rs.50,000/- towards the said charges.

The present writ petition is accordingly disposed of at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to seek release of her vehicle on payment of Rs.50,000/- towards the holding charges of the yard where the vehicle has been parked.
