This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the official respondent nos.2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondent nos.4 to 7.

In terms of order dated 12.04.2023, petitioners are present in person in the Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners on instructions from petitioner no.2 submits that he will deposit a sum of Rs.2,00,000/- in the account of petitioner no.1- Sneha within period of 15 days from today and will submit receipt in this regard in the registry of this court.

Notice of motion to official respondents only at this stage.

Mr. Vikrant Pamboo, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3.

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At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, District Yamuna Nagar (respondent No.2) to consider and decide the representation dated 09.04.2023 (Annexure P-5) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioners seeking protection for their lives and personal liberty.

Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioners and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
