ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

1. Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.329 dated 15.10.2022 registered under Sections 323, 325, 452, 506 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Sadar Palwal, District Palwal, Haryana.
2. Notice served upon the official respondent through state counsel.
3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted bail by this Court vide order dated 30.01.2023 passed in CRM-M-2609-2023. He further submits that now the petitioner has filed the present petition for bail in the same FIR number and the difference is only that 307 IPC has been added later. He further submits that it is a case of version and cross-version.
4. I have heard to counsel for the parties.
5. Perusal of the petition reveals that addition of 307 IPC is not likely to change the attribution and role prayed by the petitioner which has been considered while granting bail to the petitioner for lesser offence. No doubt attempt to murder is a heinous offence, however taking into consideration the role played by the petitioner and the fact that concession of bail has already been granted to him and there is no allegation against the petitioner in the interregnum, petitioner makes out a case for bail.
6. Given above, petition is allowed subject to compliance of all terms and conditions of the order dated 30.01.2023 passed by this Court in CRM-M-2609-2023. All pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
