AMAN CHAUDHARY. J.

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to conduct a fair and impartial/independent enquiry from the rank of Inspector General of Police officer, in registration of DDR No.027 dated 02.04.2022 adding offence under Section 29 of NDPS Act, in case FIR No.58 dated 02.04.2022, registered under Section 21 of NDPS Act, at Police Station City Hoshiarpur.

2. A reference in specific is made to para 3 to 7 of the reply dated 04.07.2022, which reads thus:

“3. That it is submitted that thereafter the accused Varun Kumra and Veer Pratap Singh were arrested on 02-04-2022 and site plan of place of incident was prepared. During the investigation, the accused Varun Kumra and Veer Pratap Singh suffered confession statement and they disclosed that the petitioner who is in District Jail, Kapurthala contacted on whatsapp call and brought through someone 200 grams heroine and at the instance of petitioner one lady and boy gave 200 grams heroine to them and they do not know their names. On the basis of confession statements of the accused Varun Kumra and Veer Pratap Singh was nominated in the present case vide DDR No.27, dated 02-04-2022.

4. That it is submitted that the Police of P.S. City, Hoshiarpur got issued production warrant of the petitioner and produced the petitioner in the court of Ld. CJM, Hoshiarpur. After the

permission of the court of Ld. CJM, Hoshiarpur the petitioner was arrested in the present case on 20.04.2022.

5. That is submitted that the Police of P.S. City, Hoshiarpur is conducting investigation in the present case. After completion of investigation, the challan of the present case will be presented in the Ld. Trial Court, Hoshiarpur.

7. That it is submitted that the petitioner is habitual offender and the following cases are as under:

i. FIR No.236, dated 26-04-2016, U/s 21/61/85 of NDPS Act, P.S Bullowal, Distt. Hoshiarpur.

ii. FIR No.94, dated 17-04-2015, U/s 15/21/22/27/29/61/85 of NDPS Act, P.S. Model Town, Hoshiarpur.”

3. In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed.
4. Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
