The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the official respondents No.1 and 2 to take appropriate legal action against the respondents No.3 and 4 who are illegally and forcibly trying to take the possession of the vehicle of the petitioner bearing registration No. PB-04V-6541.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner fairly concedes that possession has not been taken by the agency.

The petition is apparently pre-mature and based on apprehension.
