This is a petition under Section 482 read with Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of the order dated 22.02.2010 and 10.03.2010 (Annexure P-3 and P-4) passed in case FIR/RC No.7(s)/99/SIU-XVI/Jammu dated 30.06.1999 under Sections 364/302 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station CBI, SIU-XVI/Jammu (Annexure P-1) vide which the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender and seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
