This is a petition under Section 482 read with Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of the orders dated 24.11.2009, 10.12.2009 and 08.01.2010 (Annexure P-3 to P-5) passed in case FIR/RC No.5/S/2001-SIU.20/SCR.II dated 10.05.2001 under Sections 364/365/342 IPC registered at New Delhi pending in the Court of Ld. Special Judicial Magistrate, Patiala, Punjab vide which the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender and seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
