In compliance of order dated 05.05.2023, status report dated 26.05.2023 has been received from Trial Court, in terms of which, petitioner – **Manjeet Singh @ Fauji** has already been convicted and sentenced in the instant case FIR, vide judgment of conviction dated 20.05.2023 and order of sentence dated 24.05.2023.
