AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 165, dated 23rd November, 2002, under Sections 406 and 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Division No.3, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

2. On 19th May, 2023 following order was passed:-

“Learned Senior counsel, on instructions from the petitioners, submits that during the pendency of the present petition, complainant/respondent No.2 has died and it is not clear as to whether LRs of the complainant have been impleaded before the trial Court or not. He seeks time to get instructions in this regard.

Learned State counsel is also directed to get instructions as to whether LRs of the complainant/respondent No.2 has been impleaded before the trial Court or not.

Adjourned to 20.09.2023.”

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Satpal Singh submits that the LRs of the complainant have not been impleaded rather daughter of the complainant has given a statement that they are not interested in pursuing the complaint.

4. In view of the statement made, the petition is disposed of as infructuous.
5. Since the main case has been disposed of as infructuous, pending application if any is rendered infructuous.
