1. The petitioner has assailed the order dated 03.02.2020 passed by the learned Family Court, Jind, vide which, maintenance @ Rs.8,000/- has been awarded in favour of the respondent.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the matrimonial dispute has been amicably settled between the parties. The petitioner has agreed to pay permanent alimony to the tune of Rs.4,25,000/- to the respondent. They have also instituted a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act for dissolution of marriage by mutual consent in the learned Family Court, Jind, wherein, statements of the parties at the stage of first motion have been recorded. A sum of Rs.2,15,000/- has already been paid and the balance amount of Rs.2,10,000/- shall be paid when the statements of the parties at the stage of second motion is recorded.

3. In view of amicable settlement between the parties, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he has instructions to withdraw the petition.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
