The petitioner herein seeks a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider his claim for regularization to the post of Sweeper in view of judgment passed by this Court in CWP No.11368 of 2012 Annexure P-4, decided on 22.04.2014, which was upheld by the Supreme Court, as well as the other judgments passed in CWP No.2326 of 2011, decided on 20.05.2015 Annexure P-6; LPA No.1700 of 2015, decided on 10.10.2017 Annexure P-7 and CWP No.1848 of 2017 (Annexure P-11).

At the very outset, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would submit that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case his representation dated 22.12.2022 Annexure P-13, addressed to respondent No.3, whereupon no decision has been taken as yet, is decided, in a time bound manner, in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Dushyant Saharan, Advocate, has put in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

Let adequate number of copies of the writ petition be furnished to the counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents during the course of the day.

Without commenting on merits of the case and keeping in view the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide representation dated 22.12.2022 Annexure P-13 of the petitioner, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
