1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous since the due payments have been made as per the earlier order dated 16.10.2023.
2. Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
3. However, State Counsel submits that specific averment has been made that one Yashpal has been associated with the petitioner-Firm and is de-facto owner of the Firm and there are arrears of Rs.8,76,29,503/- against the said Yashpal.
4. It is accordingly, clarified that we have not observed in any manner in favour of the said person since he is not a party and thus it is open to the State to take action in accordance with law.
