The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.129 dated 15.05.2019, registered under Sections 307, 506, 148, 149 of IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, at Police Station Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar.
