By way of the instant petition, the petitioner has sought the relief of pre-arrest bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.0086 dated 23.03.2023 registered at Police Station Kasola District Rewari under Sections 323, 354, 354-A, 354-B, 452 and 506 IPC.

2. Today, learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Parmila from the above-referred Police Station, apprises the Court that in compliance of the order dated 28.04.2023, as passed by the Co-ordinate Bench, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and he is also not facing trial in any other criminal case.

3. In view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioner named Sunil Kumar by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 28.04.2023, is hereby made absolute.

4. However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
