The petitioner herein has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arisen out of FIR bearing No.0093 dated 14.12.2022 as registered at Police Station Sadar Abohar, Fazilka, under Sections 363 and 366-A IPC.

2. Today, learned State counsel, on the instructions from Inspector Gurmeet Singh from the above-referred Police Station, informs the Court that in compliance of the order passed by the Co-ordinate Bench on 13.04.2023, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and since the prosecutrix has already been recovered and in her statement as recorded

under Section 164 Cr.P.C, she has stated that she had accompanied the petitioner out of her own sweet will, therefore, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required and he is also not involved in any other criminal case.

3. In view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to petitioner-Indras Singh @ Indras by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 13.04.2023, is hereby made absolute.

4. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
