The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to pay the pension, gratuity, commutation of pension, leave encashment and other pensionary benefits alongwith interest. He submitted that the representation dated 18.05.2022 has been given to the concerned authorities vide Annexure P-3, but the same has not been considered or decided as yet.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Akshita Chauhan, learned DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State of Punjab and states that she has no objection in case the representation Annexure P-3 given by the petitioner is considered and decided by the competent authority in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid position, this Court deems it fit and

proper to dispose of the present petition without calling for reply from the respondents since the prayer is made only for deciding of the representation. Therefore, without observing anything on the merits of the case, respondent No.2/competent authority is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 18.05.2022 (Annexure P-3) strictly in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from today.

The present petition stands disposed of.
