AMAN CHAUDHARY. J.

The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner and not to interfere in her peaceful life at the behest of respondent Nos.4 to 15.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide her representation dated 05.04.2023 (Annexure P-2) submitted by her. The receipt of the said representation is annexed with this petition.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Manipal Singh Atwal, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has no objection to the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 05.04.2023 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner and decide the same expeditiously, in

accordance with law.

It is however, made clear that this order shall not preclude the authorities to proceed against the petitioner, in case, she is found involved in any other civil or criminal proceedings, instituted/pending against her or pass any order if there is some evidence that surfaces regarding her involvement in a cognizable offence, for which she may be required by the investigating agency.
