Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in criminal case having FIR No.46 dated 28.8.2022 registered under Sections 399, 402 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Morinda, District Rupnagar.

2. The allegations in nutshell are that the police received secret information that the petitioners and other accused persons were present at the disclosed place and they were planning to commit robberies at different petrol pumps and rice shellers and then the police raided the disclosed place and arrested 6 of the co-accused while the petitioners are stated to have escaped from there.

3. On the last date of hearing, the petitioners were granted interim bail with direction to join investigation by this Court.

4. Today, counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners

have joined the investigation with the police in compliance of the aforesaid order.

5. State counsel on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioners and further submits that the petitioners are not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 18.4.2023 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
