Learned counsel for the parties would submit that matter stands amicably settled between the parties and police has prepared cancellation report as back as 26.09.2020, however till date cancellation report has not been presented in the Court.

Affidavit of Varun Sharma, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala, filed on behalf of respondent No.1-State. The same is taken on record.

As per affidavit, cancellation report was prepared on 29.09.2020 and due to lapse on the part of official concerned, it could not be presented before competent Court.

In view of the affidavit, it is undisputed fact that police has not found petitioner guilty of commission of any offence and cancellation report would be presented within due course.

Let report be filed within 1 month from today.

No further order is warranted and accordingly, petition at this stage is disposed of.
