The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for the issuance of directions to police/respondents No.2 and 3 for registration of FIR under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and other relevant provisions of the IPC and the Prevention of Corruption Act on the basis of the complaint dated 22.03.2022 (Annexure P-12).

On 02.05.2022, notice of motion had been issued in this case.

Today, none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

In pursuance to the notice issued on 02.05.2023, a status report dated 12.05.2023 has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State. A perusal of the same would reveal that the petitioner had appeared before the investigating agency who could not establish the *prima facie*

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commission of offence. On the other hand, the prospective accused appeared, during the course of enquiry. They brought-forth the record to establish that in fact, he (petitioner) had committed an offence.

In view of the above, the present petition is ordered to be disposed of with the liberty to the petitioner to avail his alternative remedies in accordance with the law.
