1. The petitioner was convicted and sentenced for having committed the offence under Sections 279, 304-A and 427 IPC by the learned trial Court in terms of the judgment dated 14.10.2006. The appeal preferred by the petitioner has been dismissed vide judgment dated 05.10.2007.

2. The present revision petition has been instituted assailing the aforesaid judgments.

3. At the earlier instance, none had appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Accordingly, Registry was directed to inform the counsel for the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner was informed through e-mail but none had joined the proceedings on behalf of the petitioner. Thereafter, notice was also issued to the petitioner and the same was received back with the report that he has expired on 02.11.2020 and the copy of the death certificate was also annexed with the report.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Balraj, submits that death of the petitioner had been verified. Even, none of the LRs of the petitioner have appeared to further prosecute the matter.

5. As the petitioner had died, the present petition has become infructuous.
