The present civil revision petition has been filed with the prayer that the application dated 07.10.2021 filed by the petitioner before the Rent Controller, a copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-4, for directing the respondent to pay the rent with interest, is not being decided despite expiry of more than one and half year. Further prayer is for deciding the rent petition itself in a time bound manner so that no prejudice is caused to the petitioner.
