1. The petitioners are seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.74 dated 03.03.2023 under Sections 323, 313 and 34 of the IPC registered at Police Station Dhauj, District Faridabad.

2. Vide order dated 13.04.2023, the petitioners had been granted interim anticipatory bail with direction to join investigation and the relevant part of the said order reads as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners inter alia contends that the the complainant while visiting her parental home tried to intervene in a quarrel going on between the petitioners and some boys from the neighbourhood and in the process she also received fist blows at the hands of the petitioners. The complainant was carrying a pregnancy of two and a half months and on account of the fall she miscarried.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of order dated 13.04.2023, the petitioners have joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioners having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioners are not required for further investigation much less for their custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 13.04.2023, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
