DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to release the subsistence allowance along with interest to the petitioner in terms of his suspension order dated 17.02.2020 (Annexure P-1).

On 27.07.2023, learned counsel for the respondents No.4 and 5 submitted that requisite formalities were not completed by the petitioner.

Today, learned counsel for the respondents No.4 and 5 submits that after completion of requisite formalities, an amount of Rs.20,33,009/- has been paid to the petitioner qua subsistence allowance, pertaining to the period from February 17, 2020 to July 31st, 2023 and the same is not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the aforesaid fact, however, submits that liberty may kindly be granted to the petitioner in case

something is due, the payment towards the same, be made to the petitioner, as per rules.

In view of the above, nothing remains to be adjudicated and the present petition is hereby disposed of accordingly.
