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**HARPREET KAUR JEEWAN, J. ( ORAL )**

1.           Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair and partial inquiry by adding proper Sections 376, 307 IPC in FIR No.26 dated 04.07.2018 registered under Sections 323, 354, 354-A, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 27/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Women NIT, District Faridabad against respondent No.4.
2.           Learned State counsel has informed that cancellation report in FIR No.26 dated 04.07.2018 was filed before the Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Faridabad, which is stated to be pending for 18.12.2023 for consideration. The said cancellation was filed after submission of the status report, which was filed on 06.10.2018 by way of affidavit of Gajender Kumar, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, NIT, Faridabad. Even, in para No.3 of the said status report, it is mentioned that after verification of the facts, a direction was given to the Investigating Officer for cancellation of the case and the said report had been prepared on 08.09.2018.
3.           Keeping in view the facts that cancellation report has been

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filed and petitioner will have an alternate remedy to challenge the said cancellation report by way of filing protest petition before the Magistrate or trial Court, as such, the present petition has become infructuous.

4. The petitioner seems to have lost interest resulting to her non-appearance, as such, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is dismissed accordingly. However, the petitioner is at liberty to seek alternate remedy, if she intends to avail to challenge the aforesaid cancellation report.
