PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)

1. Petitioners are in revision against the judgment dated 29.01.2007 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad, whereby the petitioners have been held to be guilty of offences punishable under Sections 148/323/325/452 IPC read with Section 149 IPC, affirming the judgment of conviction passed by trial Court dated 16.10.2004. Appellate Court at the same time denied them benefit of provisions of Probation of Offenders Act.

2. Learned counsel representing the petitioners has placed on record compromise dated 12.02.2007 (A-1) and the affidavits of victim Ram Chand son of Thandi (A-2), Vijay son of Giani (A-3), Nathu son of Tundi (A-4), Birwati wife of Vijay Singh (A-5), Dashrath son of Chattar (A-6), Gopi son of Hetlal (A-7), Savitri wife of Giani (A-8), Sumitra wife of Ram Chand (A-9), Jogender son of Giani (A-10) executed before Executive Magistrate, Palwal to submit that during the

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pendency of the present revision petition, the parties have compromised the matter. Sentence of the petitioners was suspended vide order dated 23.03.2007 passed by this Court and in last 16 years, they have not misused the concession of bail. It has been further contended that parties are of same village and it will be in the interest of harmony and peaceful existence that the old rules be not opened after 16 years.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts that the parties have in fact compromised after appearing before Executive Magistrate, the present revision petition is allowed to the extent that the sentence awarded to the petitioners is reduced to already undergone.

4. Ordered accordingly.
