This is the second petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 392 dated 29.12.2016 under Sections 279, 336, 120-B IPC and Sections 181, 192 and 196 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and Section 3(2) of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984 registered at Police Station Kasola District Rewari.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the downloaded copy of the order dated 18.04.2023 passed by the Court of JMIC, Bawal wherein it is mentioned that the petitioner in pursuance of the order passed by this Court on 13.04.2023 filed the requisite bail bonds besides furnishing the surety also given the undertaking that he will not be absented from proceedings in future or any date.

3. Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance of the order dated 13.04.2023 passed by this court, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has furnished the requisite bails bonds with surety as well as undertaking.

4. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 13.04.2023, passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 13.04.2023 is hereby made absolute, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further, he will not tamper with the evidence and influence the witnesses; shall cooperate with the investigation as and when so required.

5. The petition stands allowed.
