1. Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of FIR No. 61 dated 26.05.2012 under Sections 406/420 IPC registered at Police Station Navi Baradari, Jalandhar on the basis of compromise dated 11.06.2017 (Annexure P-2).
2. Vide order dated 11.10.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court for recording of their statements.
3. The report dated 04.12.2018 submitted by the trial Court and conveyed to this Court vide communication dated 05.12.2018 by the District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar reveals that the complainant did not appear repeatedly for recording of statement and it has been reported that the matter does not seem to have been compromised.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition on the

same cause of action if subsequently the parties arrive at a compromise.

5. In view of the submission given by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as having been withdrawn with liberty aforesaid, in accordance with law.
