This petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent nos.2 and 3 to proceed with FIR No. 108 dated 31.10.2022, under Sections 307, 323, 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana against alleged accused-respondent no.4.

Notice of motion to official respondents only at this stage.

Mr. Adhiraj Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 – Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to consider and decide the representation/application dated 06.03.2023 (Annexure P-1) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation/application, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
