1. Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing of order dated 25.04.2022 (Annexure P-6) issued by Duty Magistrate-cum-Tehsildar, Amritsar-I.
2. Learned counsel for respondent No.4 submits that this writ petition is rendered infructuous as possession of property in question was taken. Subsequently property in question has been sold in auction and possession of said property has been handed over to the auction purchaser.
3. Perusal of the file reveals that none had appeared on behalf of petitioner on the last date of hearing when this writ petition was taken up for hearing. Today again there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that petitioner is not interested in pursuing this matter any longer.
