1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 25.04.2022 (Annexure P-32) vide which the administrator has been appointed for the schools.

2. On 06.10.2023 this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

“Learned State counsel prays for an adjournment to get instructions as to whether the order dated 25.04.2022 (Annexure P-3) has been superseded and is not in operation in view of the subsequent order dated 27.04.2023 by virtue of which the Managing Committee of respondents No.4 to 6 has been proved.

Adjourned to 12.10.2023.

To be taken up at 12.00 noon.

Interim order to continue till the next date of hearing.

3. Learned State counsel has submitted that vide order dated

11.10.2022, which has been produced in the Court during the course of hearing and which has been taken on record as Mark A, it has been clarified that order dated 25.04.2022 has been superseded and is not in operation in view of the subsequent order dated 27.04.2023 by virtue of which the Managing Committee of respondents no.4 to 6 has been proved.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to rebut the stand of the State.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
