As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant, learned counsel and representative of the respondent-Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of **Rs. 5,00,000/- (Five Lakhs only)** over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statements of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellant.

Accordingly, we **dispose of** this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for **Rs. 5,00,000/- (Five Lakhs only)** in the name of the appellant with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of 45 days, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant counsel/appellant

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may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat. The above said amount be disbursed in the share of 1/3rd each of the claimants/petitioners. The share of appellant No.3-Master Pranjal be kept in the shape of FDR in the concerned Bank fetching maximum rate of interest till he attains the age of majority.

All the pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, are also disposed of.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
