1. Present revision petition has been filed by petitioner/defendant, challenging the order dated 05.01.2022 passed by learned Civil Judge (Sr. Division), Malerkotla, whereby application filed by plaintiff (respondent herein) for depositing of requisite stamp duty and penalty of Rs.10/-, was accepted.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner/defendant informs the Court that vide order dated 24.11.2022, the civil suit has been dismissed in default, as plaintiff

failed to put in appearance. Therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. However, further submits that in case the proceedings of the civil suit are restored by learned trial Court, petitioner be given liberty for revival of the present revision petition.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous with the liberty aforesaid.
