1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or directions especially in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 03.06.2019 (Annexure P-3) vide which the case of the petitioner to get the degree of MBA has been rejected.

2. On 10.08.2023, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner would be ready to reappear in one subject bearing Code No.2102 Managerial Economics in MBA Part I through the regular mode.

Learned counsel for the respondents prays for an adjournment to get instructions in the matter.

Learned counsel for the respondents has filed a copy of letter dated 21.08.2023 written by the Assistant Registrar for Controller of Examination, today in the Court which is taken on record and marked as Mark ‘A’, vide which, it has been stated that the Vice Chancellor has granted approval to the petitioner to appear in MBA first semester (reappear exam) Subject Code No.2102 (Managerial Economics) in December 2023 subject to certain conditions which have been mentioned in the said letter.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner would comply with the said conditions mentioned in the abovesaid letter and on account of the same, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.

5. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances and in view of the letter dated 21.08.2023 (Mark ‘A’), the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
