The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the event of arrest in FIR No.0078 dated 23.03.2023 registered under Sections 406, 420 of IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014 at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh submits that though vide order dated 13.04.2023, the arrest of the petitioner was stayed but petitioner has joined the investigation on 21.05.2023 and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, as the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation, therefore, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure., therefore, the present petition is disposed of as such.
