Main case

The petitioners seek quashing of the private criminal complaint No.24 dated 21.05.2013 (Annexure P13) and summoning order dated 17.01.2017 (Annexure P1) passed by JMIC, Rewari whereby the petitioners were ordered to be summoned for the offences under Sections 420/34 IPC in the said criminal complaint.

After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of this petition with liberty to take all such pleas before the trial court, at an appropriate stage. However, considering the fact that the petition is of the year 2017, the trial court is directed to expedite the trial and dispose of the same preferably within one month from today.

Since petitioner No.1 Gyan Chand has died and no LRs are impleaded, as such, the proceeding *qua* him stands abated. Petitioner No.2 who is approximately 75 years' old shall not be expected to appear on each and every date unless he has to depose as witness in the case.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforementioned.
