1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect their lives and liberty, as they apprehend threat at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

2. On instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, learned State counsel submits that an enquiry has been held in the matter and during the course of enquiry, it was found that petitioners did not apprehend any threat to their lives and liberty and even they have filed their affidavits in this regard before the police. Learned State counsel further submits that in case any complaint is received with regard to the threat to the lives and liberty of the petitioners,

appropriate action shall be taken in accordance with law.

3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required in the matter and the petition is accordingly disposed off.

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Since the main case has been disposed of, there is no need to pass separate orders in the said application and the same is also disposed of.
