Vide order dated 17.04.2023, the following order was passed
by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not named in the FIR. He was declared innocent during investigation and his name was kept in Column No. 2 of the challan. He was summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. Co-accused Gurpreet Singh has already been granted interim bail in CRM-M-9026 of 2023. The other co-accused have also been granted regular bail.

Notice of motion for 02.05.2023.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Himani Arora, AAG, Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. A copy of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to surrender within 10 days before the trial Court. On his appearance, he shall be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate. To be heard with CRM-M-9026 of 2023.”

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that in terms of dated 17.04.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner had surrendered before the learned trial Court and he was admitted to bail. This fact is not denied by the learned State counsel.

Order dated 21.04.2023 passed by Learned Additional Sessions Judge, Pathankot reads as under:-

“ Sh. Satya Mahajan Advocate has filed power of attorney on behalf of accused Gurpreet Singh and Sh. Deepak Sharma Advocate has filed power of attorney on behalf of accused Jeewan Lal Sareen @ Sonu.

Requisite bail bonds/surety bonds of accused Jeewan Lal Sareen @ Sonu have been received from the court of Sh. Manav, learned CJM , Pathankot. Ahlmad of this Court is directed to attach the bail/surety bonds of accused Jeewan Lal Sareen @ Sonu with the main file.

Both accused Gurpreet Singh and Jeewan Lal Sareen @ Sonu have not produced the further order of bail in the court. They are directed to produce the further order of bail of Hon’ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh for 12.05.2023.”

In view of above, the order dated 17.04.2023, the petitioner is already admitted to bail and the said order is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
