1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the operation of final result dated 31.03.2022 for the post of Female Constable (HAP-Durga-1) (Annexure P-8). Other prayers have also been made in the present writ petition.

2. Learned State Counsel has submitted that the petitioner has been selected for the post of HAP-Durga-1 (Female Constable) against Advertisement No.4/2020, Category No.3 and the Commission has recommended the name of the petitioner to the Director General of Police, Haryana, Panchkula vide recommendation letter bearing No.Confd./01/32/2023/807 dated 14.09.2023 and a copy of the

communication regarding the same has been filed today in the Court which is taken on record and marked as “Mark A”. It is further submitted that since, the relief has been granted to the petitioner thus, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the abovesaid statement made by learned State Counsel, the present Civil Writ petition has been rendered infructuous and same may kindly be disposed of as such. It is however prayed that the State be bound by the abovesaid statement.

4. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

5. The State would be bound by the abovesaid statement.
