Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.49, dated 14.02.2023, registered at Police Station B Division, District Amritsar, under Sections 379-B and 34 of IPC.

FIR was lodged on the statement of Daljit Kumar, as per which on 13.02.2023, three persons came on a motorcycle and snatched his mobile phone Samsung colour black Glaxy-32A. He caught hold of one person sitting behind, who fell down. He disclosed the names of two persons, who had fled away. The apprehended persons disclosed the names of the persons, who had fled away as Vishal (petitioner) and Harsh. Complainant produced the apprehended person Lakshey before the police and the FIR was registered.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused Lakshey; that recovery of mobile phone has already been effected; that petitioner is ready to join the investigation, so he be granted anticipatory bail.

Petitioner is specifically named in the FIR. His name was disclosed by the boy apprehended from the spot itself. Offence under

Section 379B IPC is serious offence and the punishment under this  
Section is up to 5 years. No ground for anticipatory bail is made out.
