1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for setting aside order dated 10.03.2023 (Annexure P-7) passed by the Assistant Collector Grade-II, Zira.

2. On a point query raised by this Court, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that an appeal is maintainable against the impugned order, although, in para 21 of the present writ petition, it has been stated that the petitioners have no other alternative, efficacious remedy of appeal or revision available to them.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file an appeal, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
