AMAN CHAUDHARY, J.

Learned counsel submits that due to unavoidable circumstances, the petitioner could not deposit Rs.4 lakh being 20% of the compensation amount well before the time granted by the appellant Court, on account of which, his bail was cancelled and arrest warrants have been issued against him. He refers to Annexures P-10 to P-12, demand drafts and submits that now the petitioner has arranged the said amount and is ready to deposit the same. After arguing for some time, learned counsel prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to surrender before the appellant Court and deposit the said amount as directed by vide order dated 22.09.2022 to be released to the complainant.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

In case, the petitioner surrenders on or before 28.4.2023 and files bail application, it be decided on the same day, subject to deposit of the aforesaid amount.
