Mr. Ankit Aggarwal, Advocate appearing on behalf of the appellants filed Vakalatnama. The same is taken on record. He has given proposal for a sum of Rs. 10,60,000/- to settle the present dispute.

As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.10,60,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal. Out of the said amount a sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Only) each be disbursed to the appellant Nos. 2 to 5 and the remaining sum of Rs. 6,60,000/- (Rupees Six Lakhs Sixty Thousand Only) be awarded to the appellant No.1-Murti Devi W/o Late Rajpal Singh, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a cheque in the sum of Rs.10,60,000/- favouring the appellants as detailed above, with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of six weeks from today. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the counsel for the appellant/appellants.

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Appeal stands disposed of.
