KULDEEP TIWARI. J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for quashing of the order/charge-sheet dated 29.10.2016 (Annexure P-4), whereby the charges were framed against the petitioners for an offences punishable under Sections 323, 506, 34 IPC.

2. Having aggrieved with the order of framing of charges by the learned trial Court, the petitioners had made an unsuccessful attempt by filing a revision before the learned Revisional Court, which was also dismissed vide order dated 1.8.2017. This led the petitioners to file the instant petition invoking the inherent jurisdiction of this Court seeking quashing of orders (supra).

3. Today, the learned State counsel on instructions imparted to him by Inspector Satyanarayan, informs this Court that out of total nine

witnesses, four have been examined, and the remaining five witnesses are still to be examined, and most of them are official witnesses, and the next date fixed before the learned trial Court is 11.12.2023, for recording of the remaining prosecution witnesses.

4. At this stage, considering the advance stage of the trial, this Court is not inclined to interfere in the impugned orders. Therefore, the instant petition is, hereby, dismissed, however, with liberty to the petitioners to raise all the pleas which have been raised before this Court at the appropriate stage of the trial. In case, such pleas are raised, the learned trial Court shall consider and pass an appropriate order.
