AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. This order shall dispose of the above-mentioned four revision petitions as the facts and issue involved are similar. For the sake of convenience, facts are being taken from CR No.1748-2022.
2. Petitioner has approached this Court for setting aside of order dated 14.02.2022 passed by the Additional District Judge, Mohali, appointing a receiver under Section 9 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short the 'Act').
3. Learned counsel for the respondent on instructions submits that since the arbitration proceedings have culminated in the award, the respondent would be availing the remedy for execution of the award and is not pressing for the relief under Section 9 of the Act.
4. In view of the statement made, no further interference is called for.
5. Revision petitions are disposed of as infructuous.
6. Needless to say that the parties would be at liberty to avail their remedies in accordance with law.
7. Since the main case(s) have been disposed of, pending application(s), if any, are rendered infructuous.
