1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent No.1 to re-issue him passport.

2. Learned counsels for the parties are *ad idem* that in FIR No.0154 dated 12.07.2017 under Sections 326, 325, 324, 323, 148 & 149 of IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Zira, District Ferozepur, police report under Section 173 Cr.P.C has already been filed and trial is pending against the petitioner and in view of Notification No.570 dated 25.08.1993, the petitioner is supposed to approach the Trial Court.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the Trial Court in terms of notification dated 25.08.1993.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
5. If the petitioner moves an application before the Trial Court in terms of the aforesaid notification, the Trial Court is requested to pass an appropriate order expeditiously.
