None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

Even on 16.05.2022 and 30.08.2022, none had appeared for the petitioner.

In the present petition, petitioner is aggrieved of the order dated 05.04.2019, Annexure P-7 whereby his GSTIN has been cancelled and 31.01.2020, Annexure P-8, whereby order dated 05.04.2019 has been upheld.

As per the reply filed by respondents No.3 and 5, petitioner had obtained the GST registration by giving a fake address in which he was a

tenant. On investigation the landlord was found to be non-existent on the address given in the rent agreement and on physical verification of the premises Godown No.22, Durga Garden Jagadhri, the same was found to be non-existent. Panchnama drawn at the spot is Annexure R-5/1 and thereafter, the abovesaid order has been passed.

Counsel for the respondents has informed that the investigation is still going on and appropriate steps will be taken.

Since none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner for the last two dates neither any replication has been filed to the reply filed by the respondents.

The instant petition is hereby dismissed.
