Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner had approached this Court for seeking construction of 18 feet wide metalled road to the Dhanis in and around the villages of Ferozepur in terms of the policy framed by the respondent-Mandi Board.

Counsel for the respondent-Mandi Board has apprised that the case of the petitioner does not fall within the policy parameters as any Dhani must have a minimum of 20 constructed houses or the population of 100. Since the petitioner does not fulfil the said criteria, the demand cannot be considered under the said policy.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition so as to pursue his remedies in accordance with law.

Disposed of as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
